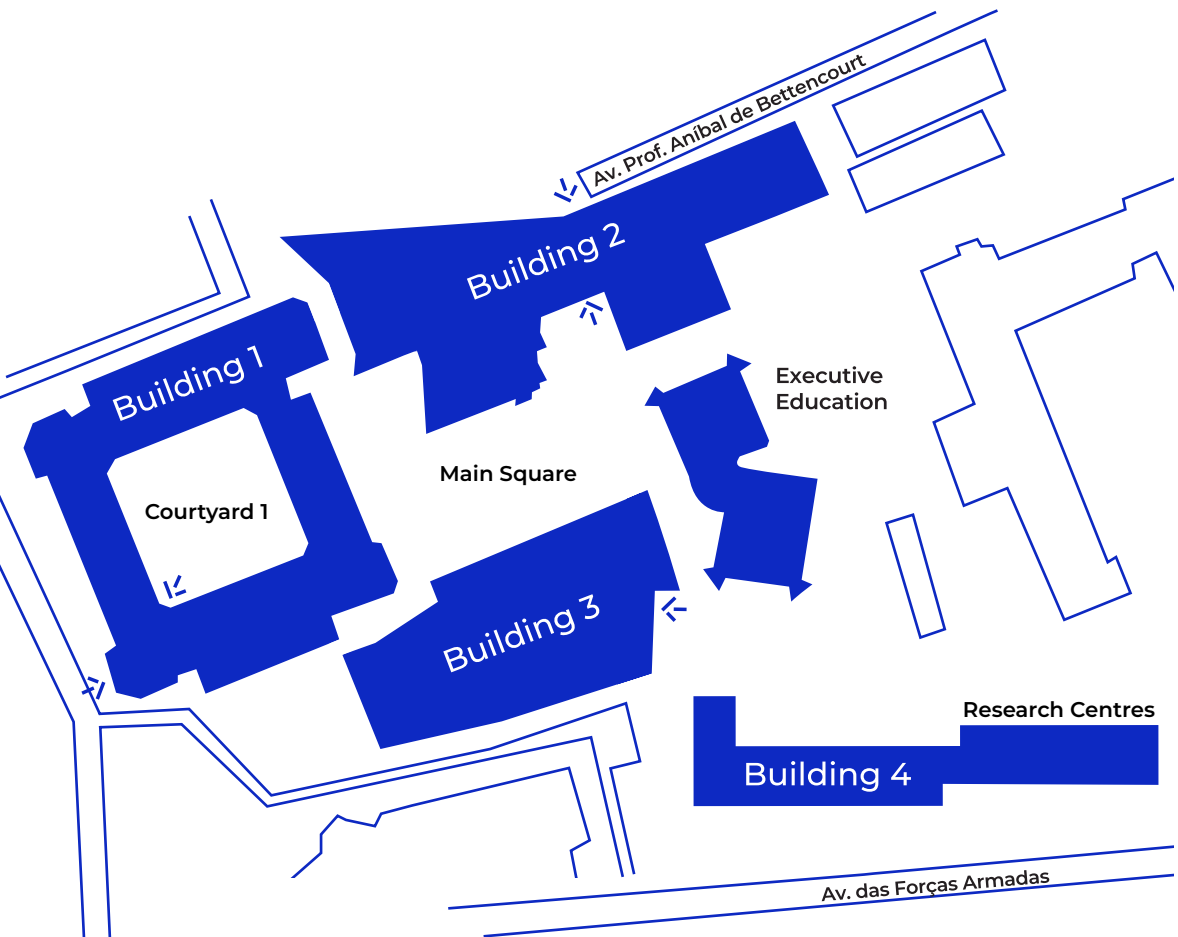

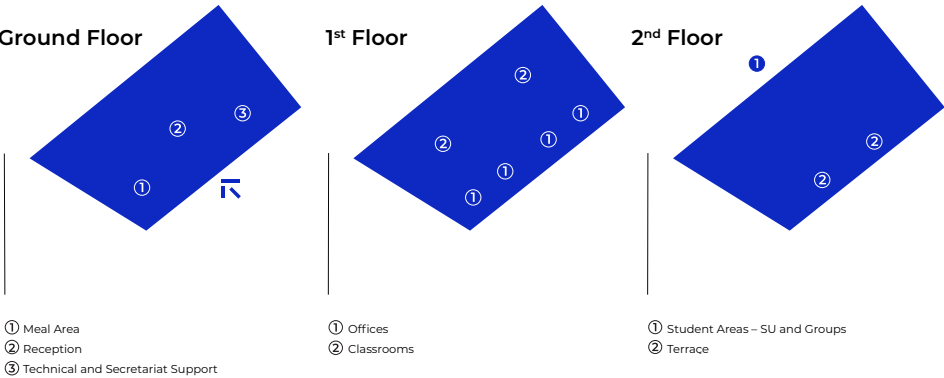
Campus Map

What to do first?

Student Account

The student account gives you access to the Wi-Fi network, institutional e-mail address, Fenix+ and Moodle, as well as other free digital resources, such as computer software, online Library catalogue, etc.

HOW CAN I ACTIVATE MY ACCOUNT?

After you activate your account, a username and an e-mail address will be assigned to you. To activate your account, follow the instructions at siic.iscte-iul.pt/iscte-user-account.

NOTE:

The e-mail address is different from the username. For example, the user Xisto Ximenes would have the following credentials:

The username is used to access Iscte's online platforms. An e-mail could be sent to both e-mail addresses and arrive in the same inbox.

It is very important that you check your student inbox regularly, given that all communications from teachers and Iscte services are sent to this address and not to your personal one.

FORGOT YOUR PASSWORD?

You can recover or change your password on the platform login.iscte-iul.pt by clicking on "Forgot your password?".

User account platforms

MOODLE

Moodle is the platform used to upload and share course-related materials, such as texts, deadlines for coursework, etc. You can access Moodle with your username and password. Go to: moodle24.iscte-iul.pt.

ONLINE LEARNING-ISCTE

The Online Learning platform is available to all users with a valid Iscte account at: online-learning.iscte-iul.pt/courses.

ISCTE WI-FI NETWORK

Wi-Fi at Iscte is accessed through the Eduroam network with the same credentials used for other platforms. For more information, go to: siic.iscte-iul.pt/en/services/networks-and-connectivity/wireless-network/#eduroam.

OFFICE 365

Office 365 is available for free. To download and install the app, use your username and password. More instructions at: siic.iscte-iul.pt/en/services/software/office-365/.

Fenix+

Fenix+ is Iscte's administrative platform. You'll find information in your Fenix+ area detailing each of the Curricular Units you are enrolled in (Curricular Unit Information, class schedules, calendars, evaluation methods, results of each CU, etc.). Fenix+ may also be used to submit requests and authenticate documents.

REQUEST FOR SPECIAL STATUTES

Applications for special statutes must be duly substantiated with documentation justifying the request.

Special statutes include Student Worker, High Performance Athlete, Union Leader or Student with Specific Educational Needs.

PART-TIME STUDENT STATUS

Attending the course part-time means that you enrol in a maximum of 36 ECTS per year. The tuition fee for part-time students is 60 per cent of the full-time fee, regardless of the number of ECTS you enrol in.

Part-time student status can be requested online upon enrolment in the course units.

Part-time enrolment is recommended in all situations in which students start their academic year later (in the case of delays in obtaining a visa for international students or prolonged absence due to sickness).

Attending the course part-time may also facilitate better academic performance in the case of students who must organise their studies around extended hours of paid work or parenting commitments.



ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Student Card

The student card allows you to register your attendance in classes. Every time you enter a classroom, you must swipe your card at the door. It is also used to access the Library, to benefit from subsidised meals in the canteen and to access Iscte during the evenings or at the weekend. The card can also be linked to a Caixa Geral de Depósitos (CGD) bank account.

Outside Iscte, the student card gives you access to special prices at various cultural and entertainment venues, such as concert halls, museums and cinemas in Portugal and abroad.



WHERE CAN I REQUEST MY CARD?

During the first few weeks of the academic year, you can request the card in person from CGD representatives at the Iscte campuses in Lisbon and Sintra. After this period, CGD will be represented once a month at the Student Services Centre. The card may also be requested at any time online at caixaonboarding.cgd.pt.

Necessary documents:

- › Identity Document;
- › Tax Identification Number;
- › Proof of enrolment/registration;
- › Proof of address (for cards linked to a bank account).

WHERE CAN I PICK UP MY CARD?

Upon registration, you will be given a temporary card. The permanent card, not linked to a bank account, may be collected at the Entrance and Integration of Students Office, in room 1S03/1S05 (Building 1). When the card is ready for pick up, a notification will be sent to your student e-mail address. Cards linked to a bank account will be sent to the address you provided upon request.

Important: You will need to activate the card on Fenix+ whether or not your card is linked to a bank account.

Course Units and Course Unit Information

Each programme is composed by compulsory and optional CUs. Each CU has a certain number of ECTS.

FIND OUT MORE

The ECTS (European Community Course Credit Transfer System) is a set of credits that allow the CU to be recognised in the European Community. An ECTS is a numerical value (between 1 and 60) allocated to each Course Unit that describes the workload required to complete it (including class attendance and the number of hours of autonomous work estimated in the CUI).

WHERE CAN I FIND COURSE UNIT INFORMATION?

Course Unit Information is available for each CU on Fenix+.

All CUs have a corresponding sheet listing its objectives, curricular programme, teaching methodologies, assessment process and recommended bibliography.

WHERE CAN I FIND INFORMATION ABOUT TEACHERS?

TIP

To access directly the profile you're looking for, simply enter the person's surname followed by [space] ciência-iul into a search engine.



EVALUATION METHOD

Assessment takes place at various times: normal period, supplementary period and special period (the latter is only available to some students).

There are two types of learning assessment: continuous evaluation throughout the semester (which includes a variety of written and oral evaluations) and evaluation by exam.

Most CUs have the possibility of choosing between these two types. However, in some courses it is strongly recommended that students are assessed throughout the semester, namely project-based courses, for which this is the only possible evaluation method.

IN-Iscte, a Space to Grow is a project that aims to support student integration and promote academic success.

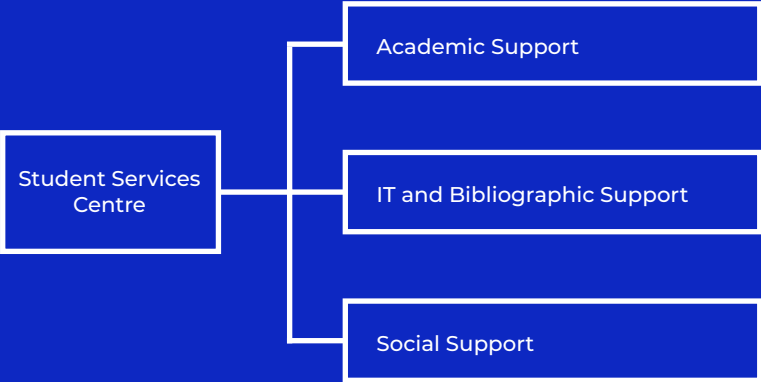
In the Mentoring Programme, second and final year students support new students. This programme seeks to build bridges between students, teachers and other Iscte staff.

LIBRARY

The Iscte Library can be found on the 4th floor of Building 2. At the library, you can access books and computers for research and consultation. The library also provides group study rooms and research offices as well as reference services with specialised assistance, training courses and a Resource Centre for Students with Specific Educational Needs. You may also request a laptop computer.



SOFT SKILLS LAB

The primary mission of the Soft Skills Lab is to coordinate training programmes that develop general competencies while enhancing academic, technical, and professional skills. In addition to the CUs offered by the Soft Skills Lab, you may also request tutoring services and personalised study support plans.

Where to Study

Iscte's facilities are accessible at any time of the day. Outside regular opening hours, access to the Lisbon Campus is available through the entrance of Building 1, upon presentation of your student card.

In addition to the Study Room (Building 1, 1st floor, North corridor) and the Library, there are areas, resources and equipment (such as tables, chairs, wi-fi, vending machines, etc.) distributed throughout the campus. As an Iscte student, you can also request study rooms for group work, although access may be limited and subject to the availability of space in the library and computer rooms. The library also has a well-equipped resource centre for students with Specific Educational Needs.

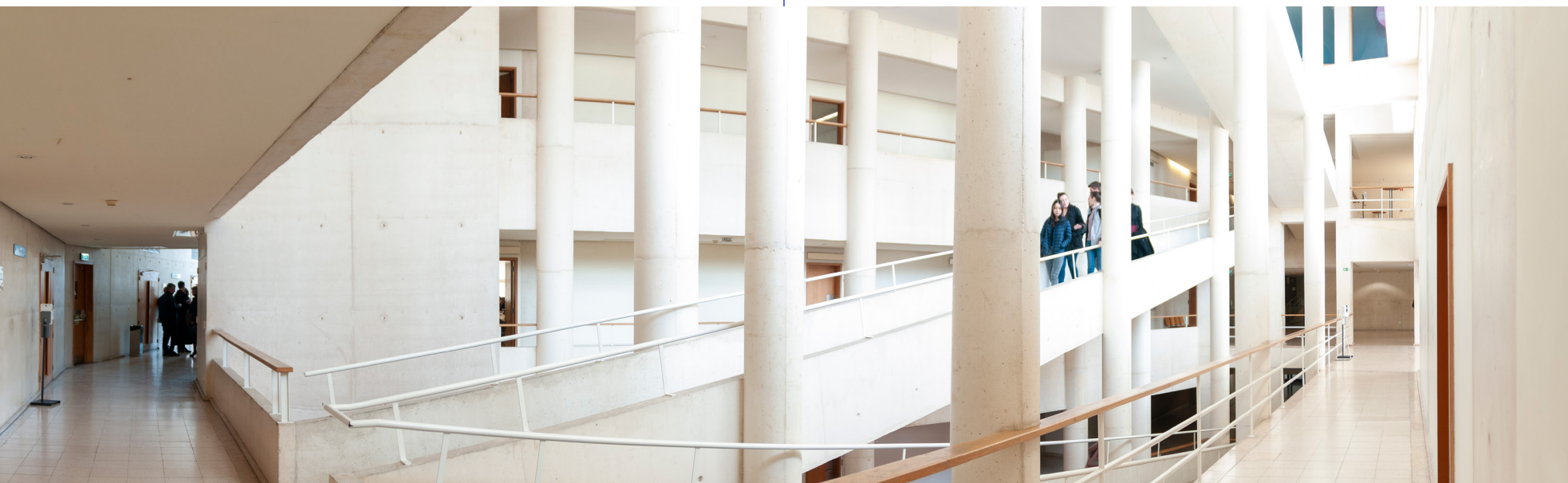
HOW CAN I BOOK A ROOM OR LAB?

Buildings 1, 2 and 3: submit a request to the Spaces Office (espacos@iscte-iul.pt). Please include in the e-mail your student number (and those of your colleagues if booking for a group) as well as the day(s) and time(s) you are interested in booking. If any specific equipment is needed, please mention it in the e-mail.

Library rooms can be booked online at: reservasbiblioteca.iscte-iul.pt/Web/index.php.

There are also public libraries near the Lisbon Campus as well as other 24-hour study spaces, such as Caleidoscópio, Espaço 24 horas (Av. Rovisco Pais) and Gare do Arco do Cego.

Iscte-Sintra has a multipurpose room where you can study from Monday to Friday between 7:30 AM and 11 PM, and on Saturdays from 7:30 AM to 6 PM.



Housing

Iscte currently provides student housing. Applications for accommodation are open all year round.

If you receive a Social Support Grant and live away from your permanent residence, you will receive priority access to student housing.

When you first enrol at Iscte, **you must tick “yes” in the “Residence required” option** on the scholarship application form.

During the 2024/2025 school year, the Odivelas Monastery will be remodelled for student housing with capacity for 204 beds, divided into 100 single rooms and 52 double rooms. It is expected that these facilities will be operational by the 2025/2026 school year.

Iscte-Sintra students can apply for a place at the Pousada de Jovens de Sintra (Av. Dr. Miguel Bombarda n.º 25/25A) at affordable prices. The application must be submitted at the time of enrolment.

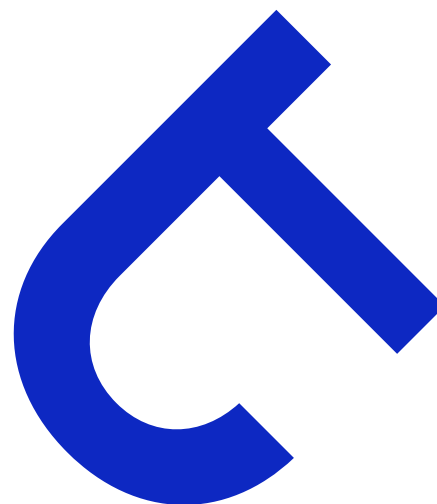
In addition, the school's administration provides access to a database of accommodation offers in the Sintra area.

Public Transport Pass



The *Navegante* pass allows you to use all public transport options (bus, metro, train and tram) in the 18 municipalities of the Lisbon Metropolitan Area. In the city, the pass also allows you to access GIRA – Lisbon’s bicycle-share network.

It is valid from the first to the last day of the month and it is free to students up to and including the age of 23. If you do not qualify for the free package, the price is €30 for those travelling within the city or €40 for those travelling between different municipalities in the metropolitan area.

As a student, you will need to provide proof of enrolment to apply for the pass. You may download your proof of enrolment on Fenix+.

- › The pass can be acquired in person at the Lisbon City Council offices (Edifício Central, Av. Campo Grande 25) at Navegante® Carris Metropolitana or at train stations as well as online at: metrolisboa.pt/en/buy/.
- › If you want a Navegante card without specific benefits, you may obtain it directly at one of the Navegante points available in all Metro stations in Lisbon. To find out more, go to: metrolisboa.pt/en/buy/navegante-card/.

SAMS-ISCTE CLINIC

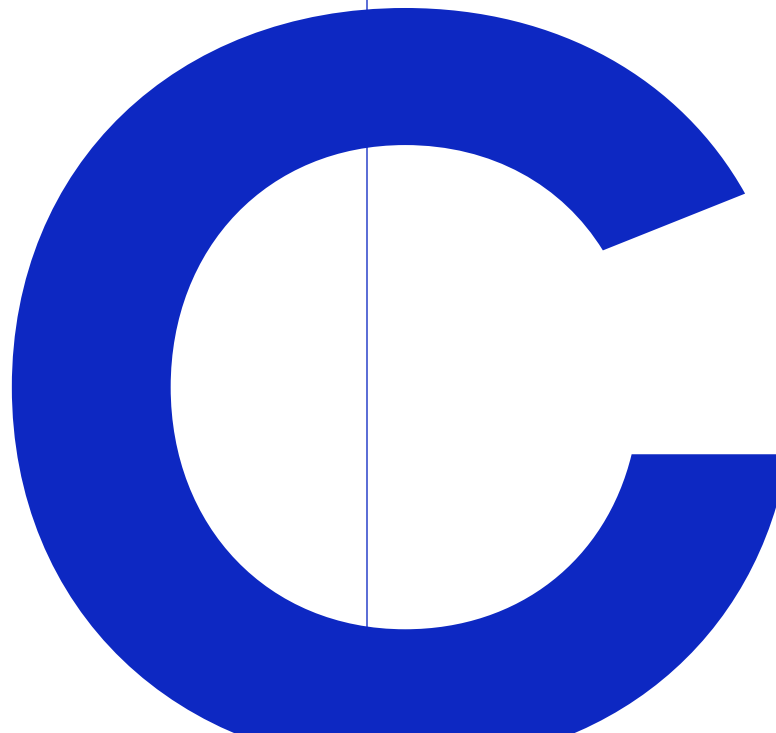
The SAMS-Iscte Clinic is located at the East door of Building 1 on the Lisbon Campus and offers various medical and nursing services to the Iscte community.
